

Footpath No.39 – Whitmore Vale Road to the Surrey county boundary

Note: There is a stile and steps on this path

A finger post on Whitmore Vale Road points to a stile which leads into a private garden. (Pic 1)

The path weaves its way through the garden, down some steps and under a bamboo 'tunnel' (Pic 2) to cross the Barford stream on a bridge made of railway sleepers (Pic 3).

This is the county boundary with Surrey where Headley FP39 ends and Surrey FP1 begins.

The path carries on through a gate (Pic 4) and up some steps (Pic 5) to meet a bridleway (Surrey BW32).

There is a guide post to our path (Pic 6, reverse direction).


Turning left down BW32 takes you to Barford and is often used as part of a circular walk.


