


The Outer Ring ®

Distance approximately 21½ miles/34.5km

This walk can start at several convenient points, and proceed in a clockwise or anticlockwise direction according to choice.



Choice of starting points

There are 'official' car parks on or close to the ring at Frensham Great Pond, Hindhead, and Liphook – but you will find plenty of other places where a car or two may be parked conveniently and some of these are marked on the map above: near Kettlebury Hill, Woolmer Forest and at Broxhead Common. You may also be able to park on request at one of the hotels or pubs on the circuit.

As a suggestion, a starting point at Frensham Great Pond offers convenient mid-point stops at Hammer, Liphook or Griggs Green.

Direction of travel

Instructions for all the walks whose outer parts make up the ‘ring’ are written in a clockwise direction (except for the lower part of Walk 14, the Flora Thompson Trail, if this is used – see map p.76).

There is, of course, nothing to prevent you from ignoring this convention and doing it withershins!

Mix and Match

You can also construct your own circular walks, for example by linking together Walks 2 & 10, or Walks 11, 12, 5, 6 & 3.

Remember in your planning that walks to the east of our area tend to involve more gradients than those to the west.
